### **OUR NEXT BRISBANE MORNING TEA – A fascinating voyage of discovery of the plant wonders at the Brisbane Botanic Gardens, Mt-Coot-tha**

On Thursday 28 August 2014 our next Brisbane morning tea will take us to the Brisbane Botanic Gardens at Mt Coot-tha, in Brisbane's western suburbs.

The event will commence with Morning Tea at The Botanical Café where we will meet Ross McKinnon AM, Curator-in-Charge for a briefing on the history of the Gardens and its outstanding features. This will be followed by tours with volunteer guides to include a short walk visiting the Cool Temperate Gardens; Cacti and Succulents Gardens; Japanese Garden; Fernhouse; Tropical Display Dome and the Bonsai House. Members with mobility difficulties should note that only walking tours will be available – However if mobility is such that you feel you may not be able to do the walks you are still warmly welcome to join us. You may instead care to soak up the surroundings from the comfort of The Botanical Café and nearby gardens.

The event is costed at just \$20 per person and everyone is asked to meet at the entrance of the Botanical Café at 9:45am for a 10am sharp start.
