## Secondary Schools Citizenship Awards 2024

Information to assist schools nominating a student

Please read before completing nomination form on next page

- (1) Only students in year 12 may be nominated.
- (2) Only a school can nominate a student for an award; students can not nominate themselves.
- (3) A nomination consists of the nomination form (next page) and a one (1) A4 page statement of the student's community service. Additional material over and above the one A4 page statement of community service will not be considered.
- (4) The member of staff who writes the one page A4 statement of community service must sign the statement and include their name and position in the school.
- (5) The nomination form needs to be **endorsed by the School's Principal** (or equivalent).
- (6) A nomination must reach the SSCA Coordinator no later than Wednesday 31 July 2024.

#### ADDRESSING THE ONE PAGE STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICE

This statement needs to address the student's commitment to his/her school and to the community under the following five broad headings. It must not be longer than one A4 page.

- participation in social service activities at the school
- engagement with the community outside the school
- involvement in the school's co-curricular life such as music, sports, societies and clubs
- examples of leadership shown by the student in school life (formal and/or informal)
- comment on the student's character

This profile should be provided by a member of staff with good knowledge of the student's achievements. The success of a nomination is determined by how well the information in this Statement is presented.

#### Advice for school principals & students about the status of the awards.

These awards are presented by The Order of Australia Association, a separate entity to the Order of Australia under the Australian Honours system. A successful student should refer to their award as a "Secondary Schools Citizenship Award" received from The Order of Australia Association, Queensland Branch". These awards are NOT awards in the Order of Australia and do not carry a post nominal after the successful student's name
