Australia's longest serving television weather presenter

About Jenny Woodward OAM

Jenny was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) in the 2024 Australia Day Honours for service to the broadcast media, particularly to television. She is a familiar face to Queenslanders, from Burketown to Birdsville, and Cape York to Coolangatta as ABC TV News weather presenter.

Jenny began her television career at Channel 10/4/5a in Toowoomba before moving to Brisbane in the 1980s to join the Wombat program at Channel 7.

Since joining ABC News, Jenny has presented the weather from a huge variety of locations across Queensland, including the EKKA where she is usually surrounded by unruly animals and birds. She has also presented national weather bulletins on ABC News Channel and is a familiar voice on ABC Radio.

She performed her one-woman stage show, Weathering Well, across Queensland in 2021-22 including 6 sell out shows at Brisbane Powerhouse.

She has worked in the industry for over 40 years and was made a Fellow of the University of Southern Queensland in 2021.

It's believed she is Australia's longest serving weather presenter.
