STUDENT CITIZENSHIP AWARDS 2025

Nominations are now invited for the 2025 Student Citizenship Awards. Each school or college is entitled to nominate from Years 11 and/or 12, one or two students who satisfy the criteria listed below for these prestigious awards.

Please note: Students nominated for this Award in past years are eligible to be renominated, but any student previously recognised in the Top 10 by the Governor will be ranked only on achievements since that recognition.

The awards are intended to recognise those senior students who contribute broadly to school and/ or the general community rather than for specific academic or sporting achievements. The Awards exemplify the Association's objective:

To celebrate and promote outstanding Australian citizenship

All nominations received are considered by an adjudication panel, and those students judged worthy of recognition will receive a special medallion and certificate signed by Her Excellency the Honourable Frances Adamson AC, Governor of South Australia and Patron of this Branch of the Association.

The ten students judged most worthy will receive a 'With Distinction' certificate and a special plaque with medallion at a reception at Government House hosted later in the year by Her Excellency. At this ceremony, the annual **Keith 'Chook' Fowler OAM** Award for the 2025 Student Citizen of the Year will be announced.

In keeping with the aim of the Association to raise awareness about the Order of Australia, each School can have a member of the Association – an Australian Honours recipient – attend a suitable school function, probably in term 4, to present the Student Citizenship Award medallion and certificate to the recipient student.

Arrangements for the member's attendance will be coordinated by the Convenor in conjunction with and subject to approval from the school / college.

The assessment and selection for the Awards will be based on the criteria set out in the accompanying pages. Please use this 2025 Nomination Form to lodge all nominations.

Selection Criteria 2025

For each nomination, the following will be used to identify and assess the nature of service to the school and community:

- Achievements that display significant benefits for the broader and school communities.
- Citizenship, leadership and skills in organisation, management and communication.
- Concern for the well-being of disadvantaged others in need, such as (but not limited to)
 homeless youth, refugees, elderly or those with a disability,

AND / OR

Making a significant contribution to the development and/or sustainability of the environment or community

The above criteria have been incorporated into two text boxes so that the submission should follow the appropriate headings to succinctly address the criteria with relevant supporting evidence.

Submissions should be written electronically in the third person, using a minimum font size of 11 or 12, and prepared by the staff member or school contact making the nomination.

The nomination should be supported and endorsed by the Principal.
